Vans drive home anti-violence idea

MESSAGES against family violence have been driven around town to change attitudes in Hume and beyond.

During Week Without Violence, held annually in the third week of October, Dia-

nella Community Health splashed the message across its vans to highlight the serious issue of family violence.

About 56 family violence incidents are reported to police each week in Hume,

but Dianella population health team leader Sabitra Kaphle said it was preventable. She said a community forum would take place late next month ahead of the 16 Days of Activism campaign.
